



































Do's & Don'ts of a Poll Watcher
Poll Watchers may walk around the Polling/Tabulation areas to observe what is occurring.

Do not stand within 6 feet of any voter at a Voting Station.

Poll Watchers may take notes via traditional writing methods (e.g., Pen/Pencil and Paper).
Only talk or ask questions of the Poll Manager and only when they are not helping a voter.
Do not interrupt a Poll Manager when they are assisting a voter.


Poll Watchers must exit the poll to use their cell phones or Other Electronic Devcies.




Do's & Don'ts of a Poll Watcher

Trying to Influence voters:


Inside the Poll; or
Inside the prohibited elections zone (150 feet of entire Building Not just the entrance)


Disrupting the Election Operations.
If you have any Campaign Stickers on your vehicle the 150 apply to those too.


